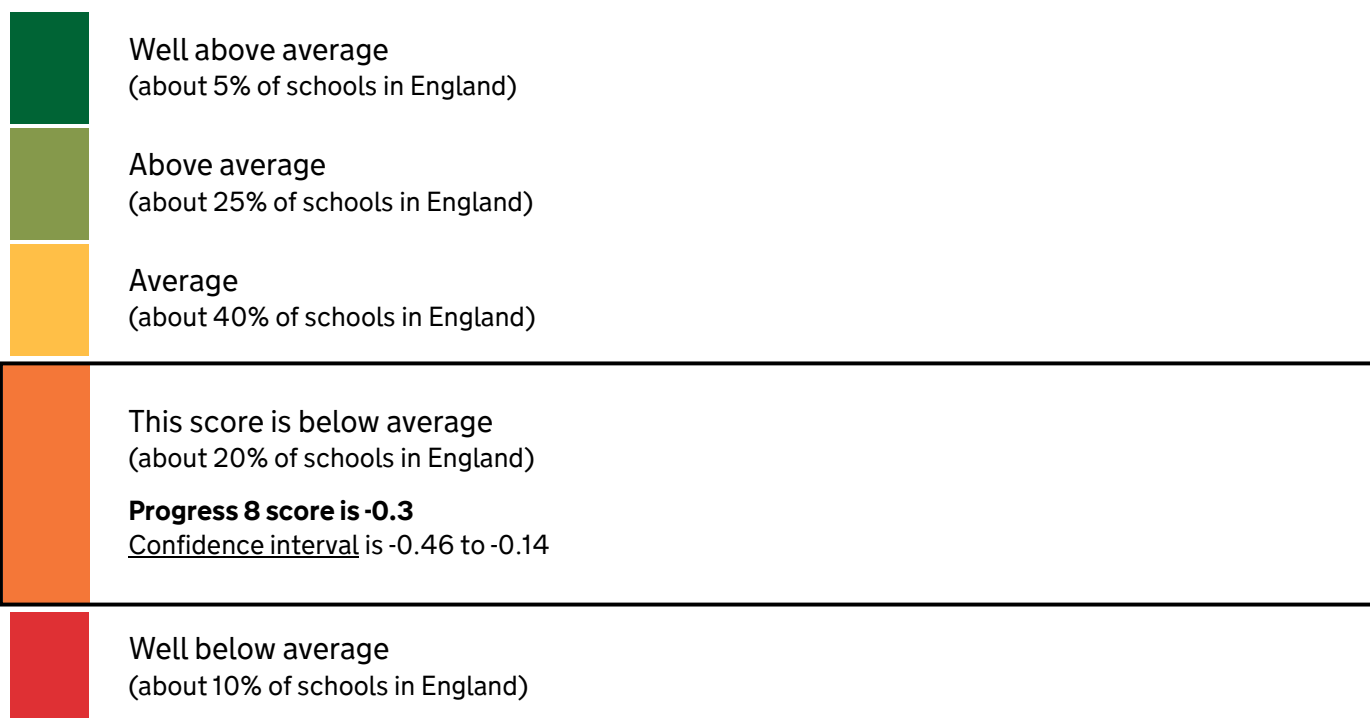


'Progress 8' score (progress made during secondary)

Progress 8 tells us how well pupils at this school have progressed between the end of primary school (key stage 2) and the end of secondary school (key stage 4), compared to pupils in other schools who got similar results at the end of primary school. include English, maths, 3 qualifications including sciences, computer science, history, geography and languages, and 3 other additional approved qualifications
