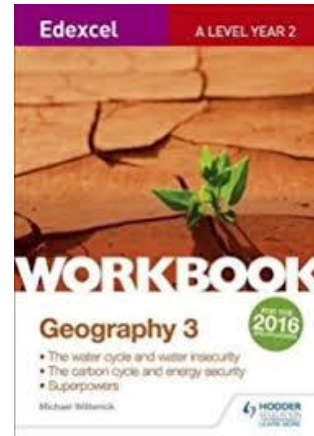
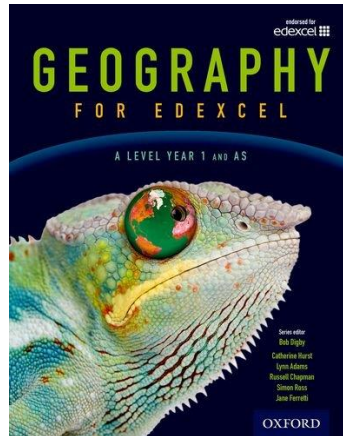
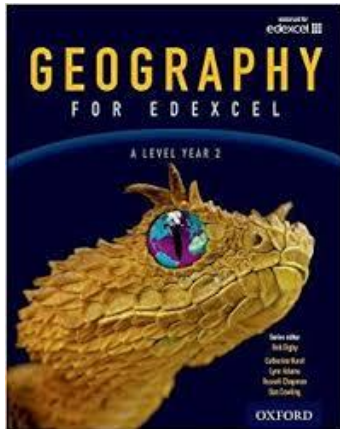

- To demonstrate your independent learning skills.

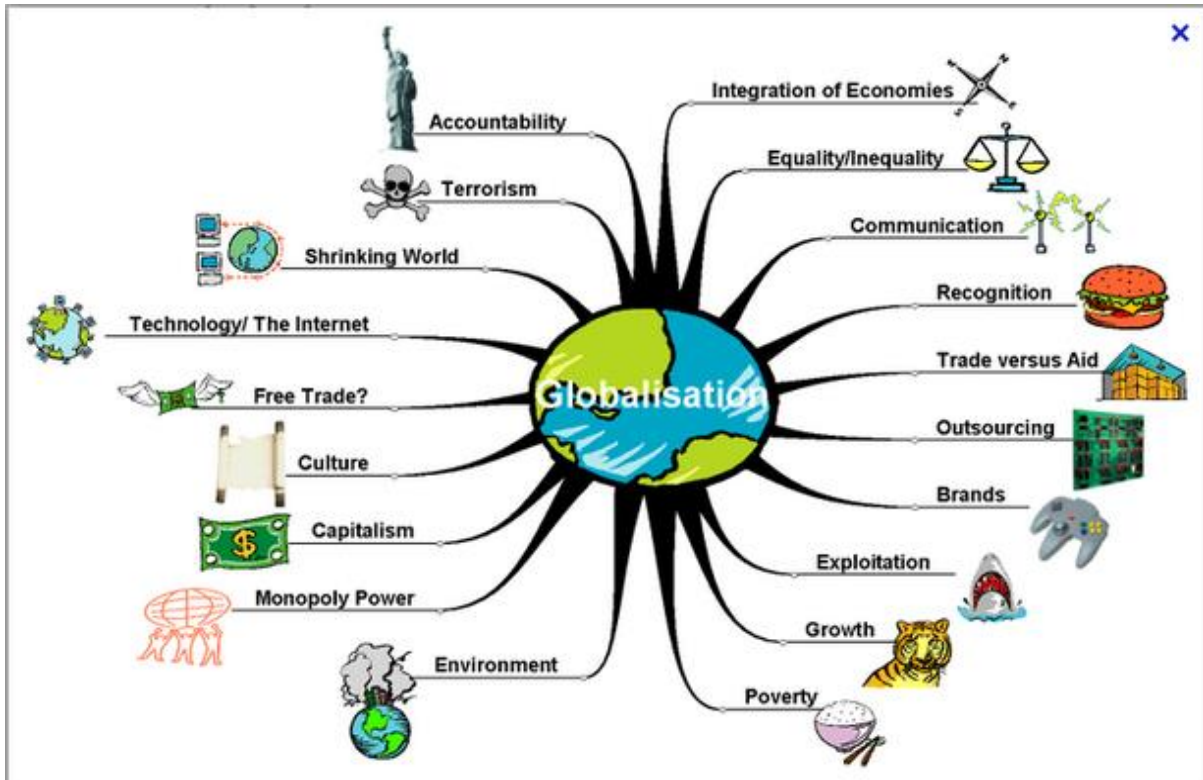
Your task is to produce a research booklet that how globalisation has developed over time. It should be 6-8 pages in length and cover the following aspects / areas / sections.
