About the Internship Programme

- ◆ The internship programme is a unique enrichment opportunity for Sixth Form Students in year 12, which runs alongside A' level or BTEC studies.
- ◆ The programme supports students to find opportunities in a range of specialist areas, allowing those involved to gain valuable experience in their chosen field.
- ◆ Internships aim to create a challenging opportunity for talented and motivated students to gain experience, build confidence and develop research skills
- ◆ Internships are student-led and shaped by the individual. Although the interns are fully supported, and some experiences are arranged for them, it is the student's responsibility to be proactive in seeking other opportunities relevant to their interests.
- ◆ Application is selective, and highly competitive, giving students invaluable experience of a serious application process.

Core Programme Contents

All students on the Internship Programme will:

- ◆ Undertake A' level or BTEC courses
- ◆ Work towards an Extended Project Qualification (EPQ)
- ◆ Take part in a team building challenge
- ◆ Undertake a leadership role within school
- ◆ Participate in skills based workshops
- ◆ Complete a work experience placement
- ◆ Have access to mentoring from industry professionals
- ◆ Gain presentation skills and experience





Application Process

Students who are expecting to study at Framwellgate School Durham Sixth Form and wish to participate in the Internship programme must complete a formal application form.

They will be invited to an interview, for which they will be asked to prepare a short presentation.

The application process is designed to replicate a formal job application. Applicants should take the process seriously as places are assigned based on applications, interviews and references.

Students selected for a place on the Internship programme must be prepared to balance their academic work with the additional demands of the Internship programme.





Law
